

Dear Mr. McCormack:

At its meeting on November 18, 1986, the New Hampshire Personnel Appeals Board reviewed your request for a hearing on behalf of the above-named individuals to appeal their current step placement in salary grade 19.

Upon review of the record in this matter, the Board found there were no material facts in dispute.

1. Quality Control Reviewer positions in the Division of Human Services were reviewed by the Division of Personnel as a result of a June 24, 1985 request from Richard Chevrefils.
2. The review resulted in upgrading the Quality Control Reviewer positions from Salary Grade 18 to Salary Grade 19.
3. The June 20, 1986 decision approving the reallocation resulted pursuant to Per 306.04(5)d of the "Rules of the Department of Personnel," in an effective date of July 5, 1985.
4. Ms. Godbout was promoted from Case Technician I to Quality Control Reviewer on February 14, 1986, some seven months after the effective date of the reallocation of Quality Control Reviewer positions.
5. Ms. McCormack was promoted from Case Technician I to Quality Control Reviewer on February 28, 1986, some seven months after the effective date of the reallocation of Quality Control Reviewer positions.

Based on the foregoing, the Board finds that these employees were not entitled to an additional increase at least equivalent to one annual increment in grade 18. Thus, they are appropriately placed in Step 1, Grade 19.

The appeals of Ms. Godbout and Ms. McCormack are hereby denied.
