


APPEAL OF RICHARD SAVORY Request for Reconsideration

At its meeting of February 22, 1989, the Personnel Appeals Board, Commissioners Cushman and McNicholas sitting, reviewed the request for reconsideration filed by SEA Field Representative Stephen J. McCormack on January 16, 1989 in the appeal of Richard Savory.

The Board voted to reaffirm its original decision of December 28, 1987, finding that Mr. Savory failed to file a timely appeal of denial of retroactive compensation following the March 26, 1987 decision which upgraded Case Technicians at the Division of Human Services.

APPEAL OF RICHARD SAVORY Request for Retroactive Compensation

December 28, 1988

On Tuesday, December 13, 1988, the Personnel Appeals Board, Commissioners Cushman, Brickett and Platt sitting, heard oral argument in the retroactive pay appeal of Richard Savory, a former Case Technician for the New Hampshire Division of Human Services. Mr. Savory was represented by SEA Field Representative Stephen J. McCormack. Daniel J. Mullen, Assistant Attorney General and Personnel Director Virginia A. Vogel represented the State.

By order of notice dated November 29, 1988, the Personnel Appeals Board notified the parties that a limited hearing on this matter would be held on December 13, 1988 for the Board to consider legal argument by the parties on the issue of timely filing of Mr. Savory's appeal.

Based upon the information provided, the Board voted unanimously to dismiss the appeal of Richard Savory for failure to timely file his appeal. The Board further voted to grant the State's Request for Findings of Fact and Rulings of Law filed on behalf of the Division of Personnel by Assistant Attorney General Daniel J. Mullen by letter dated December 9, 1988.
