NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPEAL

Dear Mr. St. Hilaire:

In the matter of Appeal before the Personnel Appeals Board (PAB) #2014-D-006, the appellant, Shari King, is withdrawing this appeal. Ms. King, not knowing the processes involved in the Personnel Rules, regarding appeals, had filed an appeal with the Board and started the Process of Informal Settlement, concurrently. The SEA has informed Ms. King that trying to follow both processes of appeal for the same issue of discipline concurrently, is not in the spirit of the Rules and as such she needs to choose a forum.

Ms. King has chosen to access the Process of Informal Settlement, and as such the SEA is working with her to continue her appeal through the Informal Settlement Process, knowing that the appeal could still end at the PAB. However, she has opted to try to settle the appeal at a lower level before having to file with the Board.
