March 30, 2011


The Appellant is asking the Personnel Appeals Board to determine whether a policy adopted by the Appellee violates the Collective Bargaining Agreement. The Personnel Appeals Board has jurisdiction to hear appeals by permanent employees concerning the application of the New Hampshire Personnel Rules.

The determination of whether an agency policy violates the CBA is not a matter over which the Personnel Appeals Board has jurisdiction. Appellee's motion to preclude argument or exclude evidence with regard to whether the policy violates the Collective Bargaining Agreement is granted.


