By letter dated November 24, 1997, Gail Morrison, a Hearings Officer employed by the Public Employee Labor Relations Board, requested a hearing to appeal a letter of warning dated October 1, 1997. In her hearing request, Ms. Morrison requested that the Board postpone the scheduling of any hearing until PELRB Chairman Haseltine returned from out of state. Ms. Morrison filed similar requests on March 3, 1998, and on August 7, 1998.

The appellant shall have ten days from the date of this notice in which to show cause why this matter should not be scheduled immediately for a hearing on the merits of the appeal, or be dismissed for lack of prosecution.
