
***APPEAL OF JEAN BARNES***


The New Hampshire Personnel Appeals Board (Wood, Rule and Barry) met on Wednesday, October 25, 2000 under the authority of RSA 21-I:58, I to consider both the State's October 12, 2000 Motion to Dismiss and the appellant's October 25, 2000 Objection to Motion to Dismiss the above-titled appeal.

The State asserts, without contradiction, that Ms. Barnes failed to apprise the Board of Medicine of her original appeal. The State also asserts, without contradiction, that Ms. Barnes subsequently failed to provide the Board of Medicine with a copy of her response to the June 19, 2000 Order of the Personnel Appeals Board, although the Personnel Appeals Board's order specifically instructed the appellant to properly file a copy of her response with the Board of Medicine. For the reasons set forth in the State's Motion, particularly as set forth in paragraphs 14 and 15, and in light of the appellant's disregard of the Board's June 19, 2000 Order, the Board voted unanimously to GRANT the State's Motion, thereby DISMISSING Ms. Barnes' Appeal.
