APPEAL OF MARGARET HEALY Docket #91-P-27 New Hampshire Real Estate Commission



A quorum of the New Hampshire Personnel Appeals Board (Bennett and Rule) met Wednesday, June 5, 1991, and reviewed its May 7, 1991 order in the appeal of Margaret Healy, an employee of the New Hampshire Real Estate Commission. By letter dated April 18, 1991, Ms. Healy had requested that she be allowed to "Reserve the Right to Appeal the decision Valerie B. Lanigan made on April 11, 1991" denying Ms. Healy promotion to the position of Licensing Coordinator.

The Appeals Board's Order of May 7, 1991, directed Ms. Healy to file an amended notice of appeal containing a description of the action giving rise to her appeal, as well as a detailed explanation of why Ms. Healy believed that action was inappropriate. The Board ordered that the amended appeal be filed within seven calendar days, or not later than May 14, 1991, or the matter would be dismissed.

Ms. Healy failed to file an amended notice of appeal, either within the time specified or by the date of the Board's June 5, 1991 meeting. Accordingly, the Board voted to dismiss Ms. Healy's appeal pursuant to Per-A 206.03(a) of the Rules of the Personnel Appeals Board.
