
The New Hampshire Personnel Appeals Board (Bennett, Rule and Barry) met Wednesday, October 9, 1996, under the authority of RSA 21-I:58, for a mandatory pre-hearing conference in the above-captioned appeal. Mr. Burgess, whose appeal was filed pro se, had appealed his June 28, 1996, termination from employment prior to completion of his probationary period as a Certified Nursing Assistant. John Martin, Esq., appeared on behalf of Glenclyff Home for the Elderly. Neither Mr. Burgess: nor any person representing him, appeared for the prehearing conference as scheduled.

Mr. Martin moved for dismissal of the appeal on the basis of the appellant's failure to appear as scheduled. After determining that Mr. Burgess had neither requested a continuance, nor provided notice either to the Board or to the agency that he would be unable to attend the prehearing conference, the Board voted to dismiss his appeal.
