APPEAL OF MANUEL GEHRING

The New Hampshire Personnel Appeals Board (Rule, Johnson and Wood) met on Wednesday, July 30, 1997, under the authority of RSA 541-A, for a prehearing conference in the above-captioned appeal. Peta Chandler appeared on behalf of the State. Mr. Gehring, who was appealing his termination prior to completion of his probationary period, failed to appear.

The appellant was notified by order dated June 27, 1997, that the Board had scheduled a mandatory prehearing conference in connection with his appeal. He was advised that a request to reschedule that conference would only be considered for only the most exceptional circumstances, and that such requests had to be made in writing and be received by the Board within ten (10) calendar days of the date of the notice in order to be considered. The appellant was also warned that failure of an appellant to appear as scheduled could result in the immediate dismissal of the appeal. No such request was ever received by the Board, nor has the Board received any communication since that date from the appellant showing good cause why he would be unable to appear.

Accordingly, the Board voted at its meeting of July 30, 1997, to dismiss Mr. Gehring's appeal. Whereas the order dismissing the appeal was an oral order given at that meeting, this shall serve as written notice of the Board's decision.
