The New Hampshire Personnel Appeals Board (Wood, Rule and Johnson) met on Wednesday, June 30, 1999, under the authority of RSA 21-I:58 and RSA 541-A, for a mandatory pre-hearing conference in the appeal of Abdul K. Khan, a former employee of the Adjutant General's Office. Mr. Khan was appealing his termination from employment as a Custodial Watchman.

By notice dated June 11, 1999, the Board advised the parties that, "Except for good cause shown, failure of an appellant to appear as scheduled shall result in dismissal of the appeal." Neither Mr. Khan nor any other person representing Mr. Khan appeared as ordered. Neither Mr. Khan nor anyone representing him, requested that the meeting be postponed, or notified the Board of a *bona fide* emergency that would prevent the appellant or someone representing the appellant from being present at that meeting.

The Board voted to dismiss the appeal unless, within ten calendar days of the date of this order, the appellant can show good cause for his failure to appear for the scheduled meeting. Failure to comply with this order by the close of business on Thursday, August 5, 1999, shall result in the dismissal of the appeal with prejudice.
