### APPEAL OF RICHARD RIX

Order for More Specific Facts


At its meeting of January 10, 1990, the Personnel Appeals Board reviewed the appeal of Richard Rix, a former employee of the New Hampshire Pari-Mutuel Commission, as filed by SEA General Counsel Michael C. Reynolds. Appellant did not deny any of the allegations contained in the October 17, 1989 letter from Pari-Mutuel Director John Furgal accepting his resignation, including that Appellant had, on October 16, 1989, walked off the job, turned in his Commission issued property, and informed the office staff that he had resigned.


On appeal, Mr. Rix argues that "on the job harassment...culminated in [his] leaving work on October 16, 1989...", and that such harassment exacerbated an anxiety condition for which Appellant was receiving medical treatment.' He contends that he was "in no condition to work after that time, but does desire to return to his job".


The Board hereby directs Appellant to produce a statement describing specifically those incidents of harassment which he alleges to have caused his inability to stay on the job, and a complete explanation of his activities on October 16, 1989. This information shall be provided to the Board and the appointing authority within ten calendar days of the date of this order.
