

**Directions To:
NORTHERN NEW HAMPSHIRE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY (NCF)
138 East Milan Road
Berlin, NH 03570**

Directions from the South (Concord area):

Take 93 North to Route 3, exit 35. Follow Route 3 into the Town of Twin Mountain; continue on Route 3 until you come to Route 115 (it will be on your right once you leave the Town of Twin Mountain). Take Route 115 for about 10 miles until you come to Route 2; take route 2 into the Town of Gorham (approximately 12 miles). In Gorham you will come to a stop light, at the stoplight take a left hand turn onto to Route 16 North. Take Route 16 North into the City of Berlin (approximately 7 miles). You will stay on Route 16 North through the City of Berlin. In downtown Berlin you will come to a stoplight, go straight through it. Continue on Route 16 North for another two miles until you come to a second stoplight (the second stoplight will have a bridge on your right). Turn right onto the bridge, at the end of the bridge take a left onto to Hutchins Street. Hutchins Street becomes East Milan Road. Travel approximately 1 mile on East Milan Road until you reach NCF (it will be on your right). Drive up the hill and take your first left into the parking lot. The main entrance is directly in front of the parking lot. Please bring identification with you such as a driver's license.

Directions from the North (Errol, NH):

In Errol take Route 16 South for approximately 22 miles into the Town of Milan. In the center of Milan take a left hand turn at the bridge (a store and gas station will be on your right, the bridge is across the street from the gas station). Go across the bridge and take a right turn at the end of the bridge. You are now on East Milan Road. Stay on East Milan Road for approximately six miles; NCF will be on your left. Drive up the hill and take your first left into the parking lot. The main entrance is directly in front of the parking lot. Please bring identification with you such as a driver's license.

NCF POLICY

- Park in designated areas only
- Lock all vehicle doors and close all windows
- No pets are allowed in vehicles
- Adults must surrender a valid identification. The only acceptable forms of ID are:
 1. Driver's License
 2. Non-Driver ID
 3. Military ID
