

Flu Prevention: A Guide on Where you can get Vaccinated

Everyone 6 months of age and older should get a flu vaccine every season, especially people at high risk. Flu vaccination can keep you and loved ones from getting sick with flu and reduce the risk of flu-associated hospitalization.



If you are covered by the State Health Plan, use your Anthem or Express-Scripts benefit to cover flu vaccination. There are several options where you can get vaccinated for the flu. Please contact these locations to confirm availability, scheduling, and plan coverage.

Primary Care Provider (PCP)

Contact your PCP or health care provider to schedule a vaccination. Often providers will arrange walk-in clinics or nurse-only that last 10-15 minutes per visit. Your medical coverage through Anthem will cover 100% of the cost for in-network providers.

Pharmacy

Vaccinations are available as part of your prescription drug benefit plan and covered 100% if you go to a participating pharmacy. To locate a participating pharmacy, contact Express Scripts at 866.544.1798

Community Clinics

Providers such as the Manchester and Nashua Health Departments, Visiting Nurse Associations, and other health care providers facilitate community clinics. Contact them directly or call 2-1-1 NH for comprehensive information and referral services or visit www.211nh.org.

Walk-in Centers, Retail Health Clinics, or Urgent Care

If you can't schedule a vaccination with your provider, choose from these centers or clinics for walk-in or appointments. Most are open weeknights and weekends. Call Anthem customer service at 800-933-8415. Examples include Convenient MD, ClearChoice MD, CVS MinuteClinic, or Concentra.
