**Holidays for Calendar Year 2010**

The State of New Hampshire and the State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, Inc. - SEIU Local 1984, within the framework of the current **Collective Bargaining Agreement**, have agreed that the following days will be holidays for State Employees during calendar year 2010.

New Year's Day	Friday	January 1, 2010
Martin Luther King Jr. /Civil Rights Day	Monday	January 18, 2010
President's Day	Monday	February 15, 2010
Memorial Day	Monday	May 31, 2010
Fourth of July*	Monday	July 5, 2010
Labor Day	Monday	September 6, 2010
Veterans' Day	Thursday	November 11, 2010
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday	November 25, 2010
Day after Thanksgiving	Friday	November 26, 2010
Christmas Day*	Friday	December 24, 2010

In addition to the above noted holidays, State employees who are employed on a full-time basis are eligible for Floating Holidays. Please see Article 9.6 of the 2007-2009 Collective Bargaining Agreement for the State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, SEIU Local 1984 (SEA), for the specific details.

**For information only:**

Although the following days are listed in RSA 288:1 as State holidays, they are **NOT paid holidays** for State employees under the terms of the **Collective Bargaining Agreement** between the State and the SEA. State Offices will remain open:

- Columbus Day (2<sup>nd</sup> Monday in October - October 11, 2010)
- Election Day (the day on which the biennial election is held)

\*Whereas Fourth of July, the calendar holiday, falls on a Sunday, State Offices will be closed Monday, July 5, 2010 and whereas Christmas Day, the calendar holiday, falls on Saturday, State Offices will be closed Friday, December 24, 2010. Please see Article 9.3.1 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement for the specific details.
