

Directions to Facility Locations

Police Standards & Training Facility, Concord:

From I-93 North or South: Take Exit 15W, Rte. 393 West. At the first set of lights (1/4 mile), turn right onto Commercial Street. (Note: If you reach end of Route 393 at Main Street, you've gone too far.) At bottom of short hill, turn right at stop sign (still Commercial Street). Continue on Commercial Street approximately 3/4 mile to next stop sign. Turn right onto Delta Drive, go over railroad tracks and bridge. Police Standards is down the hill on the left.

Manchester Community College, Manchester:

From I-293 North: Take Exit 7 (Rte. 3A). The college is approximately 200 yards on the left.

From I-293 South: Take Exit 6 (Amoskeag Bridge). Turn right at the end of the exit ramp. Cross bridge over the highway and then bear left at the fork. Follow signs to get onto I-293 North immediately on the right. Take your first exit, which is Exit 7 (Rte. 3A). The college is approximately 200 yards on the left.

From I-93 North or South: Take Exit 10 (Rte. 3A). At end of exit ramp, take a left and drive approximately two miles. The college entrance will be on your right.

Great Bay Community College, Portsmouth:

From I-95 South: After the Hampton Toll Booth, take Exit 3 (Greenland). At the end of exit ramp, turn left. Take the first right onto Grafton Road/Pease International Tradeport. Follow road to the end and campus will be in front of you. Turn left and then an immediate right into the parking lot.

From I-95 North: Take Exit 3A. At the end of exit ramp, turn right onto Grafton Road/Pease International Tradeport. Follow the road to the end and the campus will be in front of you. Turn left and then an immediate right into the parking lot.

From Rte. 4: Take Exit 1. At the end of exit ramp, turn right onto Pease International Tradeport. Continue to the end of the road and turn left onto New Hampshire Avenue. Go approximately 1.4 miles through the blinking light. Turn left into parking lot.



Directions to Facility Locations (continued)

White Mountain Community College, Berlin:

From North (Colebrook area): Take Rte. 26 east into Errol. Take Rte. 16 South and follow to Berlin. College is located on left, approximately one mile south of Nansen Wayside Area.

From South: Take I-93 North to Exit 35. Proceed north on Rte. 3 to Rte. 115 North. Follow Rte. 115 to Rte. 2 East. Follow Rte. 2 into Gorham. At intersection of Rtes. 2 and 16, turn left onto Rte. 16 North. Follow Rte. 16 into Berlin (approximately six miles). College is located on Rte. 16, three miles north of downtown Berlin on right.

From East (Maine): Follow Rte. 2 West into Gorham. Follow “From South” directions from “intersection of Rtes. 2 and Rte. 16.”

From West (Littleton area): Take Rte. 116 East into Whitefield, then continue to Jefferson. In Jefferson, turn right onto Rte. 2 East. Follow “From South” directions from “Rte. 2 into Gorham.”

River Valley Community College, Claremont:

From I-91 (Vermont): Take Exit 8 (Ascutney). From the north, turn left. From the south, turn right. Drive through two sets of

traffic lights. Approximately 2.3 miles from second set of lights, turn left onto North Street. Drive through first set of lights. At second set of lights, turn left onto Rte. 120. Drive approximately 2.5 miles. College is located on right.

From Interstate 89 (New Hampshire): Take Exit 12 (Sunapee, Claremont, Newport). From the north, turn right; from the south, turn left onto Rte. 11. Follow through Sunapee to Newport. In Newport, get onto Rtes. 11 and 103 to Claremont (approximately 10 miles). In Claremont, drive through 7 sets of lights. Just before 8th set of lights, bear right onto North Street. At next light, turn right on Rte. 120 North. College is located on right, approximately 2.5 miles from turn.

Glenciff Home for the Elderly, Glenciff:

From I-93 North: Take Exit 26. Follow Rte. 25 approximately 25 miles to Glenciff. Watch for large green-and-white State sign. Take first paved road (to right). Go up hill; Recreation Center will be on right.

From I-93 South: Take Exit 32. Turn onto Rte. 112 West for approximately 4 miles. Turn left onto Rte. 118. Continue for 13 miles to intersection at Rte. 25. Turn right onto Rte 25. Continue for 4 miles. Follow I-93 North directions from “Watch for large green-and-white State sign.”
