Dear Ms. Steele:

On December 18, 1991, an Agreement was constituted between the Office of Emergency Management and Mr. George D. Keller (represented by Attorney Alvin E. Nix, Jr.)

The warning letter from George L. Iverson to George D. Keller on January 4, 1991 was rescinded.

George D. Keller waives any claim to 389.25 hours as described in his December 26, 1990 memorandum.

Within ten (10) days of the execution of the Agreement Mr. Keller, through counsel, will move to amend his action in Merrimack County Superior Court (#91-C-515) to indicate that the hours claimed arise between May, 1988 and December 31, 1989.

Should Mr. Keller at any time make a claim based upon hours allegedly accrued between December 14, 1989 and December 18, 1991, the Agreement shall become void and the warning letter and Mr. Keller's rights of appeal therefrom shall be resurrected.
