Dear Mr. Henchey:

On November 14, 1986, SEA General Counsel William Briggs wrote to the Personnel Appeals Board requesting a hearing on behalf of Sandra Brady to appeal her termination from employment at New Hampshire Hospital. Mr. Briggs stated, "The letter [of termination] mistakenly assumes a resignation where there was none." On November 25, 1986, the Board informed Mr. Briggs that the appointing authority was never informed of an appeal request pending and that, pursuant to Per-A 206.03 of the "Rules of the Personnel Appeals Board" as adopted October 10, 1986, the Board could impose sanctions for such failure if it so chose. That correspondence resulted in the State Employees' Association notifying New Hampshire Hospital of the pending appeal request.

On December 11, 1986, N.H. Hospital Human Resources Director Virginia Vogel provided the Board with correspondence regarding Ms. Brady's "resignation," copies of which were also provided to Mr. Briggs.

At its meeting on December 23, 1986, the New Hampshire Personnel Appeals Board reviewed the appeal request and documentation submitted. Based upon the information submitted, the Board hereby denies Ms. Brady's request for a hearing.
