Appeal of Michael Terenzi

The New Hampshire Personnel Appeals Board met in public session on Wednesday, June 14, 2006, under the authority of RSA 21-I:58 and Chapters Per-A 100-200 of the NH Code of Administrative Rules to hear the appeal of Michael Terenzi, a former employee of the NH Department of Transportation. The hearing was scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m.


Attorney Edith L. Pacillo appeared on behalf of the Department of Transportation. Neither Mr. Terenzi nor anyone representing him appeared for the hearing as scheduled. The Board had not received a request from Mr. Terenzi or any person representing him to postpone the hearing.

At 9:20 a.m., the Chairman of the Appeals Board was able to reach Mr. Terenzi by telephone at the cell phone number that Mr. Terenzi had provided when he initially filed his appeal. Chairman Wood informed Mr. Terenzi that the Board and the Department of Transportation representative were present and waiting for him to appear. Mr. Terenzi indicated that he had spoken with Ms. Pacillo a week earlier and they had discussed continuing the appeal until July. Ms. Pacillo advised the Board that she had indeed spoken with Mr. Terenzi, but informed him that in order to postpone the hearing, he would have to file a written motion with the Board to make that request. Mr. Terenzi did not file a request to postpone the hearing.

Chairman Wood advised Mr. Terenzi that the Board was dismissing his appeal, but would allow him ten days in which to file a request to have the case re-opened, provided that he could show

good cause why he had failed to appear for the hearing as scheduled. Copies of that motion shall also be provided to Ms. Pacillo in order to allow her to respond on behalf of the Department of Transportation. If the Board does not receive Mr. Terenzi's motion by the close of business on the tenth day, the file will be closed and the appeal will be marked DISMISSED.
