The New Hampshire Fish and Game Department gives notice that Sealed proposals will be received and deposited in the Bid Box in 17 Hazen Drive, Building 2, Concord, New Hampshire by **2:00 o'clock PM, prevailing time on Wednesday, March 25, 2015** for the following project:

NEW HAMPSHIRE FISH & GAME DEPARTMENT HELICAL PIER INSTALLATION AT HOT HOLE POND

The Work in this Contract involves the installation by drilling a total of six (6) helical piers with pier caps some to include timber brackets.

Project plans, specifications and bid documents will be available electronically from the NH Fish and Game Department via email on March 12, 2015 and may be obtained by contacting Garret Graaskamp at e-mail: garret.graaskamp@wildlife.nh.gov or by calling 603-271-1748. The Department expects to start and complete this project in June 2015.

All bidders are urged to visit the site on Hot Hole Pond Road, Concord, NH. A PRE-BID CONFERENCE WILL NOT BE HELD FOR THIS PROJECT.

All Bids must be completed in both words and figures on forms furnished by the Department, and shall be submitted in a sealed envelope marked: **“Proposal for: NH FISH & GAME – HELICAL PIER INSTALLATION AT HOT HOLE POND”**, and received by the NH Fish and Game Department as specified no later than the date and time indicated above, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. No Bids will be accepted via electronic delivery or fax, etc. Companies, corporations or trade names, except sole proprietorships, must be registered with the Secretary of State (Corporate Division, Telephone No. 603/271-3244) in order to do business with the State of New Hampshire.

This project is estimated to have a construction value less than \$35,000 and therefore, a BID BOND and PERFORMANCE and PAYMENT BOND will NOT be required for the faithful execution of this contract.
