1	Is there a proposal sheet requirement? Meaning is there a certain proposal template that should be used?	While there is no standard proposal template that is required for proposal submissions, please be aware that there are certain requirements that must be understood and adhered to for all proposal submissions. Please refer to Section 4, "General Requirements", and Section 5, "Specific Requirements" of the Request for Proposal to understand exactly what information should be included in proposal submissions and how to submit.
2	Is there a offeror requirement? Meaning, is there a stipulation in which a foreign organization (since I'm in Mass) can be able to submit a proposal?	The State of New Hampshire does not discourage foreign or out of state companies from submitting a proposal. All bidders should note and be aware that there are required steps to register a foreign, in-state or out-of-state company as an approved state vendor. These steps would need to occur before the awarding of the contract via Governor and Executive Council.
