<p><b>A4.2</b></p>	<p>I am writing you regarding the P25 Public Safety radio System project. We would like to know which vendor is currently providing the services to the State? In addition, can we request a copy of the contract document or can you at least provide us some basic contract details such as the start and expiration date and the contract value?</p>	<p><b>RESPONSE:</b> The purpose of the RFP is upgrade the Department's current radio system, that does not include outsourced services. The Department services its radio system with in-house / staff.</p>
<p><b>A4.3</b></p>	<p>I am writing to inquire about the opportunity to submit a dispatch console-only proposal for RFP DOS-2017-06. Our initial review of the RFP document does not seem to indicate if this will be a single-vendor solution, or if multiple awards may be made for the various system parts.</p> <p>As this is a P25-based system, we believe it would benefit the State to take advantage of this standard technology and accept a console-only submission. This gives greater choice to the State (with potential cost savings), and does not limit your options to only those consoles that are pre-selected by the radio vendors.</p>	<p><b>RESPONSE:</b> The purpose of the RFP is upgrade the Department's current radio system, this includes its consoles.</p>

	<p>Our company, <b>XXXX</b> is a leading manufacturer of integrated dispatch/radio console systems. We have <u>supplied systems to the Oregon State Police, Oregon Dept. of Transportation, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) and most recently, we were awarded a contract with the California Highway Patrol</u> to replace their statewide console system.</p> <p>The State of Oregon was in a similar position to the State, and benefited greatly by leveraging the P25 standard and enabling them to procure the radio system and console system separately, both through competitive tender. This process gave them greater choice, more competitive pricing, and maximum features amongst the radio and console systems, which may not have been realized had the two systems been procured together.</p> <p>The State of Oregon selected Harris for the P25 radio system, and XXXXI for the console system, utilizing the P25 CSSI protocol for the integration between the two systems. This system was commissioned in January 2016 and is currently in use.</p> <p>I welcome the opportunity to discuss the merits of accepting a console-only proposal, should this be something the State is willing to consider.</p>
