





NOTES: These contracts are a result of WSCA Bid and award MA065 from the State of Utah. The purpose of the contracts is to allow all state agencies to participate in very aggressive shipping rates as part of the nationwide contracts and reporting.

NH has previously participated in WSCA contract with FedEx and was very successful. The award of the current contracts is for both FedEx and UPS and is scheduled to begin 8/27/2011. The agreements will allow Alan Quimby to shop between both vendors for best package pricing.

2010 annual spend for small package delivery was \$512,795.00 for nearly 100,000 packages for all state agencies and between both vendors with separate contracts.
