



## **2016-2017 Flu Vaccination Options**

### ***Active State of NH employees (part-time or full-time) who are covered by the Health Benefit Program can:***

- **Attend a worksite flu shot clinic:** Clinics are being scheduled around the state with Agency Human Resource Personnel. If your agency has scheduled a clinic, they will send out communication on where and when it will be held as well as the necessary paperwork to complete.
- **Utilize the Pharmacy Benefit:** Seasonal flu vaccinations are available as part of your prescription drug benefit plan and are not subject to a copayment if you go to a participating pharmacy. Choose from any of the more than 50,000 participating pharmacy locations.
  - To locate a participating pharmacy near you, contact Express Scripts at 1.866.544.1798
  - Contact the participating pharmacy to determine vaccine availability and if an appointment will be required for you and/or your covered dependents
  - Bring your Express Scripts prescription card and a valid photo ID when you go to your appointment
- **Visit Your Primary Care Office:** If billed as nurse visit or a routine well-visit, there will be no copayment required; otherwise the applicable PCP copayment would apply.

### ***Active State of NH employees (part-time or full-time) who are NOT covered by the Health Benefit Program can:***

- **Attend a worksite flu shot clinic:** Participate in a worksite flu clinic by self-paying the \$20 fee with a check made payable to "State of New Hampshire – Treasurer" and give to HR.

### ***Spouse and/or dependents of SoNH employees, SoNH retirees and their spouse and/or dependents who are covered by the Health Benefit Program can:***

- Use the Pharmacy Benefit (see details above)
- Make an appointment with their Primary Care Office (see details above)
- Visit a community vaccination clinic. Some communities in NH offer flu vaccinations at school sites, visiting nurse associations, senior centers, or grocery stores. [www.flu.gov](http://www.flu.gov)
